- Communication with mill procurement, landowners, and loggers.
- Logging supervision.
- Computer-based reporting and management.

Job Qualifications: The ideal candidate will hold the following qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in forestry or a similar discipline.
- Two or more years of related experience is preferred, but not required.
- An outstanding safety record in all aspects of previous employment history is crucial.
- The successful candidate will become familiar with Microsoft Office and ESRI software.

- Conducting performance assessments and applying appropriate control measures
- Timber-sales evaluation administration and inspections.
- Forest measurements
- GIS experience
